Application Instructions for 2023 RUC International Summer School

Since its inception in 2009, the International Summer School of Renmin University of China (RUC) has been an important initiative to promote the internationalization of talents cultivation. The International Summer School is usually held in July every year. During the International Summer School, RUC invites outstanding teachers from universities at home and abroad to provide full English courses for RUC students. Meanwhile, students from other universities worldwide can also take the courses. RUC International Summer School is committed to offering multicultural and multidisciplinary learning for students, promoting students' understanding of different countries and cultures, and cultivating their international perspective and cross-cultural communication skills.

2023 International Summer School will return to our campus from online teaching, but some of the courses will be taught online due to the former arrangement of the instructors. The detailed timetable and teaching format (online or in campus) will be released before April 7 on our website: http://iss.ruc.edu.cn/courses.php.

Duration

2023 RUC International Summer School will last from July 3 to July 21. Courses are usually taught at 8:00-11:30 or 14:00-17:30 or 18:00-21:30 (GMT+8) with one class every other day. 8 classes (16 classes for language courses) in total for each course.

Application Procedures

Step 1 Register

Register and fill your basic information in the above registration website.

After submitting your application information, please wait for the information review and the following steps can be continued after being approved.

Step 2 Check courses

2023 RUC International Summer School will have over 80 courses for you to select (see Appendix 1). Before paying the registration and tuition fees (if needed), please make sure you have appropriate courses to select and without time clash if you plan to select more than one course.

Step 3 Pay registration and tuition fees (if needed)

Amount: RUC International Summer School Office will decide whether you need to pay the fees according to the nomination of your university. If needed, the fees should be paid before selecting courses. The registration fee is 800 yuan and the tuition fee is 11000 yuan in April and 12000 yuan in May for you to select 1-2 courses. And one more course needs additional 2000 yuan.

Methods and commission rates: Chinese bank cards, oversea bank cards and Ali pay and Wechat pay are all supported to use. If you use oversea bank cards, the commission fee needs to be paid together with the registration and tuition and the rate may differ according to the bank policy.

Step 4 Select courses

Once the registration and tuition fees have been paid (if needed), the courses can be selected.

Accommodation

If you need to live at RUC, you can apply for in-campus accommodation during your online application. Due to the limited providing of the rooms, students may not book a room with a success and in this case, you can choose to be in the waiting list and you can get a room if other students who have booked a room choose to quit. If there is no room left in the end, you will have to book a hotel outside RUC campus.

Visa

If you choose to come to RUC for studying at 2023 RUC International Summer School, you should take the RUC admission letter and visa application form (Jw202), which will be sent to you after you are admitted by RUC International Summer School, to the local Chinese embassy or consulate to get a X2 Visa. Please make sure that the validity of the visa can cover the period of your staying in China.

Drop Courses

Courses can only be dropped before the third class. The details are as follows:

1.during the course selection period

Courses can be selected and dropped in the system.

2. after the end of course selection and before the start of the selected course

Courses can be dropped but not selected in the system.

3. after the course starts and before the second class

Courses can be dropped in the system; and only courses that has vacancies but has not yet started can be selected.

4. after the second class

Courses can't be dropped after the second class.

Refund for Quitting

If you have to quit RUC ISS, the registration fee won't be refunded to you, but you can have refund for tuition. The proportions of refund are as follows:

95% of tuition for quitting before the first class;

90% of tuition for quitting before the second class;

50% of tuition for quitting before the half of the course;

0 refund for quitting after the half of the course

Score Check

Generally, the scores of your selected courses can be checked in the course selection system after one week of the end of the course. Before checking the score, please complete the teaching evaluation and questionnaire in the course selection system.
